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

Our programs focus on early education, literacy, and youth development, providing a strong foundation for lifelong success.

Through our nurturing and inclusive approach, we aim to foster a love for learning, instill values of integrity and community, and provide essential resources and support to families. South Shore Stars is dedicated to creating brighter futures and a stronger, more vibrant South Shore community for all.

With a capacity for 100 students at full enrollment, this school addresses the pressing need in the region, where one in four students with disabilities require specialized instruction. Stars envisions becoming a leading independent school, prioritizing Care, Evidence-Based Educational Practices, and Joy in children's education and individualized growth. Their recent acquisition of a 30,000-square-foot facility in Weymouth at 163 Libbey Parkway marks a significant step toward realizing this vision, with plans to open its doors in 2024.

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


Afterschool Programs

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Middle & High School Programs

Randolph – 6th, 9th and 10th graders

At Stars, we empower learners of all kinds through our older youth programs. We foster academic, social, and emotional growth through engaging activities, allowing students to apply their skills in real-life situations. Collaborating with Randolph Public Schools, our programs are funded by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education Grant and private donations. Eligible students referred by Randolph Public School educators can access these programs for free. Our high school and middle school 21st Century Community Learning

Centers provide academic, emotional, and social support during and after school hours. We prioritize project-based learning that integrates academic activities with social-emotional and executive functioning skills. Students actively shape program goals, bridging the gap between school and out-of-school time. We foster strong relationships between adults and youth, promoting healthy social and emotional development. Our culturally responsive approach values differentiation, equity, and inclusivity for all students and families.





Family Support

Stars' Family Support services are here to let you know that you are not alone. Our Kinship Group meetings create shared experiences, fostering peer support and building a community. These confidential sessions provide a space to listen, share stories, and ask questions about raising children. Whether you have a child currently enrolled or have had one in a Stars program, you are eligible to join. Our participants come from all over the South Shore, including Cohasset, Hingham, Weymouth, Quincy, and Randolph. Potluck meals and childcare are provided during these meetings.

At Stars, we prioritize family support. Each of our programs have dedicated Family Support Clinicians, who are highly qualified with Masters degrees. They offer resources, referrals, and support to enrolled children and families, ensuring continuity of care between school, home, and health providers. Our Clinicians provide information on wraparound services and referrals to various resources offered by towns or state agencies. They are dedicated to prioritizing the social and emotional well-being of our enrolled families and children.
